1. The Holy Spirit possesses divine attributes

2. The Holy Spirit does Divine work  
(John 3:5-6)

3. Scripture identifies the Holy Spirit as God  
(Acts. 5:1-4)

4. The Holy Spirit is identified as the Yahweh of the OT  
(Isa. 6:9-10/Acts 28:25-27, Ps. 95:7/Heb. 3)

5. Though distinguished from the Father and the Son, the Holy Spirit is represented as equal with the Father and the Son in the great Trinitarian passages of the New Testament  
(Matt. 3:16, Matt. 28:19, Eph. 2:18)

6. The Holy Spirit comes from the Father, and is sent by the Father and the Son  
(John 14-16; 1 Cor. 11:3)
